2019-02R: CONSIDERATION AND RECOMMENDATION OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION REGULATION 4A REGARDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, CHARITABLE LOTTERIES AND CHARITABLE GAMES.

<u>PURPOSE</u>: To update and modify Regulation 4A in line with A.B. 117, passed by the Nevada Legislature on or about May 16, 2019, and approved by the Governor of Nevada on or about May 28, 2019; to modify Regulation 4A to include charitable games; to delete the definitions of "lottery approval" and "lottery approval decision" and replace them with definitions for "registration" and "registration decision;" to modify the definition of "application;" to delete the definition of "executive director;" to add a definition for "communications technology;" to establish fees concerning charitable lotteries and charitable games; to set out requirements regarding charitable lottery and charitable game applications; to set out age requirements for charitable lotteries and charitable games; to set out requirements regarding prize advertising; to set out requirements regarding statewide and online ticket sales and approval and appeal thereof; to prohibit certain charitable lottery and charitable game conduct from using communications technology; to set out record keeping requirements for qualified organizations; to adopt and modify regulations setting out procedures to appeal charitable lottery and charitable game registration decisions; and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate these stated purposes.
