The Commission having considered all information relevant thereto finds that there is good cause for appointment of a committee pursuant to Nevada Revised Statute 464.020(5). Therefore, pursuant to the unanimous vote of the Commission;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

The following pari-mutuel licensees, who are licensed to engage in off-track parimutuel wagering pursuant to Chapter 464 of the Nevada Revised Statutes, are hereby appointed to the Pari-Mutuel Wagering Committee (Committee);

Per NRS 464.020(5)(a):

- 1. Palace Station
- 2. Caesars Palace
- 3. South Point
- 4. The Orleans
- 5. Excalibur

Per NRS 464.020(5)(b):

- 1. William Hill -- Brandywine Bookmaking LLC
- 2. Cantor G&W (Nevada), L.P. dba Cantor Gaming dbat Venetian Casino Resort -Race and Sports Book
- 3. American Casino & Entertainment Properties LLC -- Aquarius Gaming LLC, dba **Aquarius Casino Resort**

Per NRS 464.020(5)(c):

1. NAV-LVH Casino, LLC, dba LVH - Las Vegas Hotel & Casino 1

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- 2. MGM Resorts International/The Mirage
- 3. Wynn Las Vegas, LLC dba Wynn Las Vegas
- 2. The Committee is granted the exclusive right to negotiate an agreement relating to off-track pari-mutuel wagering with:
- A person who is licensed or otherwise permitted to operate a wagering a. pool in another state; and
- b. A person who is licensed pursuant to Chapter 464 of the Nevada Revised Statutes as an operator of a system.
- Each pari-mutuel book shall have the authority to determine individually whether 3. to accept the terms of any agreement negotiated by the Committee.
- 4. The appointment of the committee and its authority is for five (5) successive periods of one (1) year each from the date of the Commission meeting in the month that the approval was granted and shall renew automatically for each of the five (5) successive periods unless a member of the Commission requests the matter be placed on the Commission agenda for formal consideration. Unless terminated earlier, the appointment of the Committee and its authority shall expire at midnight of the November 2018 Nevada Gaming Commission meeting on the date the matter is considered.
