5 REVISED ORDER

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7 THIS MATTER came on for hearing before the Nevada Gaming Control Board  
8 (Board) on Thursday, February 24, 2022, for the purpose of determining appointments to  
9 the Esports Technical Advisory Committee (Committee). Pursuant to Senate Bill No. 165,  
10 chapter 443, Statutes of Nevada 2021, at page 2806 (SB 165), the Board shall appoint a  
11 Committee consisting of professionals from the Esports industry. The Board having  
12 considered all information relevant thereto, including the public policy of this state  
13 concerning gaming, finds that there is good cause for appointment of certain individuals to  
14 the Committee pursuant to SB 165. Therefore, pursuant to the unanimous vote of the  
15 Board;

16 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 17 1. The Order concerning the Committee dated November 3, 2021, is hereby revised and  
18 restated, in its entirety, by this Revised Order.
- 19 2. The following eight individuals are hereby appointed to the Committee:
- 20 1. Brett Abarbanel, Ph.D.
  - 21 2. Paul Hamilton. Mr. Hamilton is an Esports industry participant and satisfies  
22 section 10.5(2)(c) of SB 165.
  - 23 3. Seth Schorr. Mr. Schorr is an Esports industry host and satisfies section  
24 10.5(2)(b) of SB 165.
  - 25 4. Lovell Walker.
  - 26 5. Christian Bishop.
  - 27 6. Jud Hannigan. Mr. Hannigan is an Esports industry broadcaster and  
28 satisfies section 10.5(2)(d) of SB 165.

1           7. Brandon Snow. Mr. Snow is an Esports industry game publisher and  
2           satisfies section 10.5(2)(a) of SB 165.

3           8. Che Chou.

4   3. Paul Hamilton shall serve as Chair of the Committee.

5   4. Unless terminated by the Board earlier, the appointment of each member of the  
6   Committee appointed herein shall expire at midnight on the last day of the November  
7   2024 Nevada Gaming Control Board Meeting.

8   5. Each member of the Committee shall serve without compensation.

9   6. A majority of the members constitutes a quorum of the Committee, and a majority of  
10   the members present at any meeting determines the action of the Committee.

11   7. The Committee shall hold meetings no more than once per calendar quarter, except as  
12   otherwise approved by the Board Chair or the Board Chair's Designee, to formulate and  
13   provide recommendations to the Board on any guidelines and parameters that may be  
14   necessary to ensure the integrity of Esports when wagers are placed on such  
15   competitions.

16   8. The Committee may use administrative support provided by the Board and approved  
17   by the Board Chair or the Board Chair's Designee.

18   9. The Committee must comply with all federal, state, and local laws and regulations,  
19   specifically including, without limitation, the Nevada Open Meeting Law.

20   10. In carrying out its duties, the Committee may not request or require the disclosure of  
21   any proprietary information, intellectual property, or trade secret.

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1 11. Minutes from each meeting of the Committee must be placed as an informational item  
2 on the next available Board meeting agenda.


