**ORDER**

THIS MATTER came on for hearing before the Nevada Gaming Control Board (Board) on Wednesday, November 3, 2021 for the purpose of determining appointments to the Esports Technical Advisory Committee (Committee). Pursuant to Senate Bill No. 165, chapter 443, Statutes of Nevada 2021, at page 2806 (SB 165), the Board shall appoint a Committee consisting of professionals from the Esports industry. The Board having considered all information relevant thereto, including the public policy of this state concerning gaming, finds that there is good cause for appointment of certain individuals to the Committee pursuant to SB 165. Therefore, pursuant to the unanimous vote of the Board;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The following seven individuals are hereby appointed to the Committee:
  1. Brett Abarbanel, Ph.D.
  2. Paul Hamilton. Mr. Hamilton is an Esports industry participant and satisfies section 10.5(2)(c) of SB 165.
  3. Seth Schorr. Mr. Schorr is an Esports industry host and satisfies section 10.5(2)(b) of SB 165.
  4. Lovell Walker.
  5. Christian Bishop.

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1           6. Jud Hannigan. Mr. Hannigan is an Esports industry broadcaster and  
2           satisfies section 10.5(2)(d) of SB 165.

3           7. Brandon Snow. Mr. Snow is an Esports industry game publisher and  
4           satisfies section 10.5(2)(a) of SB 165.

5           2. Paul Hamilton shall serve as Chair of the Committee.

6           3. Unless terminated by the Board earlier, the appointment of each member of the  
7           Committee appointed herein shall expire at midnight on the last day of the November  
8           2024 Nevada Gaming Control Board Meeting.

9           4. Each member of the Committee shall serve without compensation.

10          5. A majority of the members constitutes a quorum of the Committee, and a majority of  
11          the members present at any meeting determines the action of the Committee.

12          6. The Committee shall hold meetings no more than once per calendar quarter, except as  
13          otherwise approved by the Board Chair or the Board Chair's Designee, to formulate and  
14          provide recommendations to the Board on any guidelines and parameters that may be  
15          necessary to ensure the integrity of Esports when wagers are placed on such  
16          competitions.

17          7. The Committee may use administrative support provided by the Board and approved  
18          by the Board Chair or the Board Chair's Designee.

19          8. The Committee must comply with all federal, state, and local laws and regulations,  
20          specifically including, without limitation, the Nevada Open Meeting Law.

21          9. In carrying out its duties, the Committee may not request or require the disclosure of  
22          any proprietary information, intellectual property, or trade secret.

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1 10. Minutes from each meeting of the Committee must be placed as an informational item  
2 on the next available Board meeting agenda.


