RE: MINIMUM INTERNAL CONTROL STANDARDS – REQUEST FOR SUGGESTED REVISIONS

The Gaming Control Board is in the process of revising the current version of the Minimum Internal Control Standards (MICS), which became effective on January 1, 1997. It is anticipated that the proposed revisions will be released for public comment in May 2001. Additionally, the Board plans on conducting public workshops in June 2001 in Las Vegas and Carson City to discuss the proposed revisions and to consider industry comments. The final revisions to the MICS are expected to become effective on January 1, 2002.
