**SUBJECT: PROPOSED TECHNICAL STANDARDS FOR GAMING DEVICES AND ON-
LINE SLOT SYSTEMS**

Following the submission of industry comments regarding the proposed amendments to the Technical Standards for Gaming Devices and On-Line Slot systems, the State Gaming Control Board has finalized the proposed amendments dated June 24, 2004. A summary of the amendments made to the draft as the result of comments received at the workshop is attached. Also attached to this letter is a copy of Regulation 14.050 that includes a description of the Technical Standards adoption process.

In accordance with Regulation 14.050(2), and prior to the official adoption, the proposed Technical Standards are being provided for review and for any final written comments.
