TO: ALL NONRESTRICTED GAMING LICENSEES AND INTERESTED PERSONS

RE: NEW SURVEILLANCE STANDARDS ADDRESSING "DIGITAL VIDEO RECORDINGS" AND "SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM STANDARDS."

There will be informal meetings and discussions concerning two new Surveillance Standards that the State Gaming Control Board (Board) is considering adopting pursuant to NGC Regulation 5.160. These meetings will be attended by Board Member Bobby L. Siller and staff, and will address "Digital Video Recordings" used in surveillance systems (new Standard 11), as well as a new requirement that a failure of any part or component of a surveillance system may not result in cessation of more than 50% of the surveillance coverage of the gaming area (new Standard 12). The first meeting will be held on January 20, 2005, at the hour of 10:30 a.m., at the Grant Sawyer Office Building, Second Floor, Suite 2450, 555 East Washington Ave., Las Vegas, Nevada. The second meeting will be held on January 25, 2005, at the hour of 10:30 a.m., at the offices of the Board, Conference Room 100, 1919 East College Parkway, Carson, City, Nevada.
