SUBJECT: PROPOSED TECHNICAL STANDARDS FOR KIOSKS

USED ON CASHLESS WAGERING SYSTEMS

Following the submission of industry comments and an industry workshop held on September 1, 2004, regarding the proposed amendments to the Technical Standards for Kiosks used on Cashless Wagering Systems, the State Gaming Control Board has finalized the proposed amendments dated April 11, 2005. Attached to this letter is a copy of Regulation 14.050 that includes a description of the Technical Standard adoption process.

In accordance with Regulation 14.050(2), and prior to the official adoption, the proposed Technical Standards are being provided for review and for any final written comments. The final proposed amendments to the Technical Standards for Kiosks used on Cashless Wagering Systems can be obtained from the Board's website at http://gaming.nv.gov.
