SUBJECT: INVESTIGATIVE FEE CHANGES

The Gaming Control Board is increasing investigative fees for Restricted Licensee applicants and Regulation 25 Independent Agent filings as detailed below. The following fee schedule will become effective July 1, 2005.

DESCRIPTION	CURRENT RATE	RATE EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2005
Independent Agents	\$0	\$750/filing
Restricted Licensees		
Initial Application	\$250/ea.	\$400/ea.
Subsequent Application	\$100/ea.	\$150/ea.

In regards to Regulation 25 investigative fees, the procedures stated below must be followed:

- A. All investigative fees must be remitted in U.S. Funds.
- B. All investigative fees must accompany the registration forms. If they are not included, the form will be returned for proper submittal.
- C. Each property must notify their independent agents of the fee for any new individuals registering.
- D. For purposes of this fee schedule, independent agents are only required to file one registration to cover affiliated companies (e.g. Mirage and Treasure Island).
- E. Independent agents who work at nonaffiliated licensed locations must register for each location.
