SUBJECT: CLARIFICATION OF REGULATION 6A REPEAL ON THE

TECHNICAL STANDARDS FOR GAMING DEVICES

At its meeting on September 21, 2006, the Nevada Gaming Commission repealed NGC Regulation 6A, "Cash Transactions Prohibitions, Reporting, and Recordkeeping" in its entirety, effective at 11:59 p.m. on June 30, 2007. Please refer to the Board's website, www.gaming.nv.gov for any additional information regarding this change.

Currently, there are several standards that are directly impacted by the repeal of Regulation 6A. Regulation 14 Technical Standards 1.030(3), 2.050(1) and 2.050(2) impose \$3,000 limits associated with coin and currency accepted by a slot machine before a wager must be made or play initiated. These limits have historically been enforced by requiring that manufacturers hard code these limits. In anticipation of the removal of these standards, these limits are no longer required to be hard coded. Manufacturers will still be required to allow operators to configure the limits to allow compliance until the standards are removed.

This change in compliance requirements is effective immediately.
