**NOTICE OF HEARING FOR REPEAL OF A REGULATION OF THE NEVADA  
GAMING COMMISSION AND STATE GAMING CONTROL BOARD**

The Nevada Gaming Commission will hold a public hearing on or about the hour of 9:30 a.m. on Thursday, March 22, 2007, in Conference Room 2450, 555 East Washington Avenue, Las Vegas, Nevada, for the purpose of repealing the following regulation:

• **NGC REGULATION 13, "LIVE ENTERTAINMENT TAX."**


**Purpose:** To repeal Nevada Gaming Commission (NGC) Regulation 13, entitled "Live Entertainment Tax," in its entirety: to clarify that Nevada gaming licensees that are subject to the Live Entertainment Tax must continue to comply with the applicable provisions of Nevada Revised Statutes 368A and Nevada Administrative Code Chapter 368A, instead of NGC Regulation 13; to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate this stated purpose.

The proposed regulation amendments will be considered by the Commission in accordance with the provisions of NRS 463.145 which allows that on the date and at the time and place designated, any interested person, or their duly authorized representative, or both, shall be afforded the opportunity to present statements, arguments or contentions in writing, with or without the opportunity to present the same orally.

In addition, these proposed regulation amendments are agendaed for discussion at the Nevada Gaming Commission meeting on Thursday, February 22, 2007, in Conference Room 100, 1919 College Parkway, Carson City, Nevada, on or about the hour of 9:30 a.m.
