**RE: STATUTORY COMPLIANCE WITH NRS 353.1467 REQUIRED BY
JULY 1, 2008**

Effective July 1, 2008, the State of Nevada will require money owed to any state agency of \$10,000 or more be made by electronic transfer.

NRS 353.1467 states:

1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, all payments of money owed to a state agency for taxes, interest, penalties or any other obligations that, in the aggregate, amount to \$10,000 or more must be made by any method of electronic transfer of money allowed by the state agency...

3. If the payment of money owed to a state agency is required pursuant to this section to be made electronically, the electronic payment must be credited to the State of Nevada on or before the date that such payment is due...

(Added to NRS by [2007, 3312](#), effective July 1, 2008)

The State Gaming Control Board (Board) will require licensees to submit payments using the Automated Clearing House (ACH) CTX format. Licensees will need to contact their individual banks to set up the payment process. It is the licensees' responsibility to ensure that forms and fees are received on or before the required due dates. Failure to file and pay by the due dates will result in penalties.

The Board will send a subsequent letter to licensees prior to the statutory deadline providing the format and detailed information required to be submitted with payments. If you have any questions, please contact Supervisor Paula Ward in the Board's Tax and License Division at (775) 684-7770.
