**SUBJECT: NEVADA GAMING DEVICE APPROVAL STATUS DATABASE**

The State Gaming Control Board's Technology Division, which is responsible for the review and approval of gaming devices, has released a new application that will allow a user to look up the approval status of gaming device programs in Nevada. The application will also allow the user to perform hash operations on a known image and verify its status in the public database. The "Hash Verifier" application can be downloaded from the Gaming Control Board's website at [www.gaming.nv.gov/hash\\_verifier.htm](http://www.gaming.nv.gov/hash_verifier.htm).

Operators can use this application to assist in the compliance with Slot MICS #91. The Hash Verifier database currently only includes SHA-1 signatures for EPROM images, but will be expanded to include signatures for programs stored on non-conventional media such as compact flash and hard drives in the near future. Currently the user can verify that approval status of all programs in Nevada.
