NOTICE OF HEARING FOR ADOPTION OF AN AMENDMENT TO REGULATION(S) OF THE NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION AND STATE GAMING CONTROL BOARD

The Nevada Gaming Commission will hold a public hearing on or about the hour of 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, May 21, 2009, in Conference Room 2450, 555 East Washington Avenue, Las Vegas, Nevada, for the purpose of considering adoption of the following proposed regulation amendment.

NGC REGULATION 8.060, "PARTICIPATION IN OPERATIONS."

<u>PURPOSE OF AMENDMENT</u>: To provide that an employee who proposes to acquire an interest in any licensed gaming operation, in a licensee, or in a holding company shall not take any part in the conduct of such gaming operations or in the operation of the establishment at which such gaming operations are conducted while his application for a license to acquire such interest is pending unless such employee has been employed there for more than six months prior to filing his application and when he files his application he requests permission from the Board Chairman to continue to be so employed pending Commission action on his application and the Board Chairman does not deny the request; and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate these stated purposes.

The proposed amendment will be considered by the Commission in accordance with the provisions of NRS 463.145 which allows that on the date and at the time and place designated, any interested person, or their duly authorized representative, or both, shall be afforded the opportunity to present statements, arguments or contentions in writing, with or without the opportunity to present the same orally.

In addition, this regulation amendment is agendaed for discussion at the Nevada Gaming Commission meeting on Thursday, April 16, 2009, in Conference Room 100, 1919 College Parkway, Carson City, Nevada, on or about the hour of 10:00 a.m.
