RE: PROPOSED CHANGES TO REGULATION 3.100 EMPLOYEE REPORT

The Gaming Control Board ("Board") is currently working on a project to substantially modify and bring clarity to the interpretation and semi-annual reporting requirements for employees as defined in NGC Regulation 3.100. Public workshops were held on February 11, 2010 and February 16, 2010 in both Carson City and Las Vegas to receive public input. As a result of that input, please find attached the current working draft of the Board's NGC Regulation 3.100 regulatory requirements.

A careful read of this proposed language will indicate that the volume of employees to be reported has been significantly reduced. This is the objective of the current draft. Also, note that Group I and Group II licensees have slightly differing requirements. The language recognizes that there are distinct differences in these types of operations.
