II. WORKSHOP AGENDA

- **NGC Regulation 3.100 – “Employee report.”**

Purpose of amended regulation: To provide definitions for “compensation,” “complimentary benefits,” and “qualifying employee;” to revise those persons who must be included within the employee report; to revise the dates of submission of the employee report; to broaden types of licensees required to submit an employee report to include manufacturers and distributors; to clarify the period of time covered by the employee report; to revise the information that must be contained in an employee report; to allow a single comprehensive employee report to be submitted by a licensee holding multiple licenses; to allow the board chairman or his designee to waive requirements of this section and impose alternative requirements upon good cause shown; and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate these stated purposes.

- **NGC Regulation 12.060 – “Use of chips and tokens.”**

Purpose of amended regulation: To allow licensees to redeem chips and tokens presented to them by governmental entities which lawfully come into possession of such chips and tokens and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate these stated purposes.
