SUBJECT:	Applications – Interactive Gaming and Service Providers

Assembly Bill 258 (AB 258) passed by the 2011 Legislature requires the Nevada Gaming Commission to create regulations authorizing, subject to certain limitations, the licensing of manufacturers of interactive gaming products, operators of interactive gaming, interactive gaming service providers and service providers. Due to an increasing level of interest, applications for these approvals may be submitted to the Gaming Control Board prior to the passage of said regulations.

Applications to manufacture interactive gaming products, to operate interactive gaming, to operate as an interactive gaming service provider, or any service provider seeking to share in the revenue from games should be treated in the same fashion as for any nonrestricted gaming license. Any other type of service provider should submit applications in the same manner as for a restricted gaming license.
