SUBJECT: NOTICE OF HEARING FOR CONSIDERATION AND/OR ADOPTION OF AMENDMENTS TO REGULATION 8.060 AND REPEAL OF REGULATION 22.035 OF THE NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION AND STATE GAMING CONTROL BOARD

The Nevada Gaming Commission will hold a public hearing for the purpose of considering adoption, amendment or repeal of the regulation(s) stated below. The public hearing will be held on or about the hour of 10:00 a.m. on January 24, 2013 via video conference at the following State Gaming Control Board locations: Grant Sawyer Building, Hearing Room 2450, 555 East Washington Avenue, Las Vegas, Nevada and the State Gaming Control Board, 1919 College Parkway, Carson City, Nevada.

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO REGULATION 8.060

PURPOSE: To expand when administrative approval may be granted by the board chairman for employment of a person at a licensed gaming operation while the person has an application pending for a license at the location or an application pending to acquire an interest related to the location, to remove the employment prohibition for persons intending to acquire an interest in a restricted gaming licensee, and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate these stated purposes.

PROPOSED REPEAL OF REGULATION 22.035

PURPOSE: To repeal Regulation 22.035 pertaining to registration of certain individuals associated with race books, sports pools and call centers, pursuant to Governor Sandoval's Executive Order No. 2011-01 directing agencies to identify and repeal regulations that are no longer necessary and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate this stated purpose.

The proposed regulation changes will be considered by the Commission in accordance with the provisions of NRS 463.145 which provides that on the date and at the time and place designated, any interested person, or their duly authorized representative, or both, shall be afforded the opportunity to present statements, arguments or contentions in writing, with or without the opportunity to present the same orally.

This matter will be heard by the Nevada Gaming Commission at the January 24, 2013 meeting, and may be continued and heard at subsequent meetings of the Nevada Gaming Commission as required to effectuate the above stated purposes. This notice is also posted on the Commission's web site at www.gaming.nv.gov as required by NRS 463.145.
