**SUBJECT: CLARIFICATION OF NOTICE # 2013-83 REGARDING ITEMS FOR
CONSIDERATION AND/OR ADOPTION BY THE GAMING COMMISSION AT
ITS NOVEMBER 21, 2013 MEETING.**

The Nevada Gaming Commission (Commission), at its October 24, 2013 meeting, will consider and possibly take action on Commission Agenda Item 13 regarding Senate Bill (SB) 425. That action would only be to determine whether pari-mutuel wagering rebates are or are not in the best interests of the State of Nevada. If the Commission votes "Yes", then the Commission's responsibilities are to consider adopting regulations to implement the offering of rebates. The latter is what is being noticed for the November meeting because the law requires a 30-day notice for the Commission to consider regulations. Notice #2013-83, sent out earlier today, was necessary in order for the Commission to be able to act on possible regulations in November.
