**SUBJECT:** Gaming Device on a System Interoperability Field Trials

Effective January 1, 2015, the Board no longer requires an interoperability field trial for a gaming device on an approved online slot metering or cashless wagering system. A manufacturer will continue to be required to have the interoperability functionality of the gaming device with each system certified by and Independent Test Lab and approved by the Board.

Certain functionality, such as the use of coupons, electronic promotional credits in/out, and wagering account transfers may continue to require an interoperability field trial.

This notice does not preclude the Chairman from allowing or requiring an interoperability field trial in accordance with NGC Regulations 14.130 or 14.280 at his discretion.
