**2015-04R: POSSIBLE AMENDMENTS TO NGC REGULATIONS 6 AND 14 TO EFFECTUATE
SENATE BILL 9 PASSED DURING THE 2015 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**

REGULATION 6

PURPOSE: In accordance with NRS 463.145, NRS 463.150, and S.B. 9 passed during the 2015 Legislative Session, to amend regulation 6.110 to clarify the computation of gross revenue for slot machines or gaming devices; and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate these stated purposes.

REGULATION 14

PURPOSE: In accordance with NRS 463.145, NRS 463.150, and S.B. 9 passed during the 2015 Legislative Session, to amend regulation 14 to add and/or amend definitions including, but not limited to, “game of chance,” “game of skill,” “hybrid game,” “identifier,” “skill”; “control program,” “manufacture,” and “modification;” to create a policy statement for the commission; to amend the provisions pertaining to themes that are prohibited in association with gaming devices or slot machines; to amend the minimum standards for gaming devices; to require manufacturers, distributors, and manufacturers and distributors of associated equipment to notify the board in writing if an approved gaming device or associated equipment no longer complies with the regulations of the commission; to amend the information an application for approval to modify an inter-casino linked system must contain; and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate these stated purposes.

**2015-05R: POSSIBLE AMENDMENTS TO NGC REGULATIONS TO EFFECTUATE
SENATE BILL 445 PASSED DURING THE 2015 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**

PURPOSE: In accordance with Senate Bill 445 passed during the 2015 Legislative Session, discussion and consideration of possible amendments to Nevada Gaming Commission Regulations to effectuate Senate Bill 445 which directs the Nevada Gaming Commission to adopt regulations relating to global risk management. The purpose of these regulations is to set out the services provided by a book engaging in global risk management; to set out requirements of books engaging in global risk management; to set out that the chairman may object to agreements between books providing global risk management services to Nevada licensees; to set out the effects of such an objection; and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate these stated purposes.

The proposed regulation changes will be considered by the Commission in accordance with the provisions of NRS 463.145 which provides that on the date and at the time and place designated, any interested person, or their duly authorized representative, or both, shall be afforded the opportunity to present statements, arguments or contentions in writing, with or without the opportunity to present the same orally.

These items will be heard by the Nevada Gaming Commission at the August 20, 2015 meeting, and may be continued and heard at subsequent meetings of the Nevada Gaming Commission as required to effectuate the above stated purposes.
