**SUBJECT: ANNUAL REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL MANUFACTURERS
AND DISTRIBUTORS OF GAMING DEVICES**

Pursuant to Nevada Gaming Commission Regulation 14.180(6) and Nevada Revised Statute 463.650, this notice will serve as a reminder to all manufacturers and distributors of gaming devices.

The Gambling Devices Act of 1962, 15 U.S.C. §§ 1171-1178, requires registration by any person or entity engaged in the business of manufacturing, repairing, reconditioning, buying, selling, leasing, using, or making available for use by others any gambling device before any such device enters interstate or foreign commerce.

The registration form is located on the website of the United States Department of Justice (DOJ) at www.justice.gov/criminal-oeo/gambling-device-registration.

On or before the 15th day of January of each calendar year, you must provide the Board a copy of the documentation evidencing registration with the United States Attorney General pursuant to the provisions of the Gambling Devices Act of 1962, 15 U.S.C. 1173, for the ensuing year.

A copy of the DOJ letter confirming your compliance must be submitted to the Board via email to slots@gcb.nv.gov and maintained in your records.
