**SUBJECT: ANNUAL REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL MANUFACTURERS  
AND DISTRIBUTORS OF GAMING DEVICES**

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The Nevada Gaming Commission (Commission) will be considering possible action to repeal subsection 6 of Regulation 14.180. This regulation requires manufacturers and distributors annually provide the Nevada Gaming Control Board (Board) a copy of the documentation evidencing registration with the United States Attorney General pursuant to the provisions of the Gaming Devices Act of 1962, 15 U.S.C. Section 1173, for the ensuing year.

This proposed amendment will be heard by the Commission after the January 15<sup>th</sup> filing deadline.

Pursuant to Regulation 14.180(10), Chairwoman Morgan waived the reporting requirements in subsection 6 of Regulation 14.180 until after the Commission has considered the proposed amendment.

If the Commission adopts the amendment to repeal Regulation 14.180(6), manufacturers and distributors will no longer have to provide the documentation mentioned above to the Board, but they are still required to comply with the provisions of the Gaming Devices Act of 1962.
