Effective June 2, 2025, investigative fees for Restricted Gaming License Applications will be calculated pursuant to the following schedule:

Single Entity or Sole Proprietor	\$2,000
Slot Route Operator/Space Lease	\$2,000
Entity + 1 Individual	\$3,000
Entity + 2 Individuals	\$4,000
Entity + 3 Individuals	\$5,000
*Each additional entity or individual	\$1,000

In addition to the investigative fees, pursuant to NGC Regulation 4.070, each individual or entity being investigated still requires the \$500 application fee.

The Investigative fees for Restricted gaming applications have not been revised since January 2012. Consequently, this new investigative fee schedule more closely reflects the actual investigative time and work required by NGCB agents and employees to process each application.

Please note that applications requiring a disproportionate amount of investigative time may require additional investigative fees beyond those listed above.
