- a. The application of Wynn Resorts, Limited, for a three-year approval of a continuous or delayed public offering by it or any affiliated company wholly-owned by it which would thereby become a publicly traded corporation ("Affiliate").
- 2. THAT for a period of three years, Wynn Resorts, Limited, and its Affiliate(s) are hereby granted approval, pursuant to NGC Regulation 16.115, to make public offerings, subject to the following conditions:
- a. That at all times during the three-year period, Wynn Resorts, Limited, and its Affiliate(s) shall timely file all reports required by Section 13 or Section 15(d) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended;

	b.	That upon filing documents with the United States Securities and Exchange
Commission	("SEC")	regarding the sale of any securities for which approval would otherwise be
required, Wyr	nn Reso	rts, Limited, and its Affiliate(s) shall contemporaneously provide written
notice and co	pies of s	such documents to the Board's Investigations Division - Corporate Securities
Section ("Divi	sion"), a	nd shall keep said Division continuously and promptly informed as to the
progress of a	ny public	c offering made hereunder; and

upon the issuance of an interlocutory stop order by the Chair of the Board. Said interlocutor
stop order, if issued, shall remain in effect until the interlocutory stop order is lifted by the
Commission upon such terms as are satisfactory to the Commission.
