ORDER

This matter having come before the NEVADA GAMING COM-
MISSION on September 18, 1980, on the recommendation of the
NEVADA GAMING CONTROL BOARD that THRIFT CREDIT CORP., BURTON I.
KOFFMAN, and MILTON KOFFMAN be found unsuitable as lenders to
A.E.S. TECHNOLOGY SYSTEMS, INC., and M. & R. INVESTMENT COMPANY,
and as equity holders of A.E.S. TECHNOLOGY SYSTEMS, INC., and
MILTON KOFFMAN having appeared before the NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION
on behalf of himself, BURTON I. KOFFMAN, and THRIFT CREDIT CORP.,
the COMMISSION does hereby unanimously find that:

During its April, 1980, meeting, the NEVADA GAMING
COMMISSION, acting on the recommendation of the Board, directed
that the above-referenced corporation and individuals file an
application for finding of suitability as a lender to M & R IN-
VESTMENT COMPANY and Morris Shenker and as a lender and equity
holder of A.E.S. TECHNOLOGY SYSTEMS, INC.,

Formal notice was sent to A.E.S. TECHNOLOGY SYSTEMS, INC.
and M & R INVESTMENT COMPANY and both letters were received on
May 9, 1980, advising them of the 30-day deadline for filing;


1 No application for finding of suitability has ever been
2 filed by THRIFT CREDIT CORP., BURTON I. KOFFMAN, or MILTON KOFFMAN,
3 nor did any of them nor any agent or counsel of any of them appear
4 before the GAMING CONTROL BOARD at its September 10, 1980, meeting
5 at which consideration of this matter had been scheduled, and;

6 That the failure of THRIFT CREDIT CORP., BURTON I.
7 KOFFMAN, AND MILTON KOFFMAN to file the aforementioned application
8 was deliberate.

9 WHEREFORE the NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION hereby finds and
10 orders that THRIFT CREDIT CORP., BURTON I. KOFFMAN, and MILTON
11 KOFFMAN are unsuitable as lenders to A.E.S. TECHNOLOGY SYSTEMS, INC.,
12 and M & R INVESTMENT COMPANY, and as equity holders of A.E.S.
13 TECHNOLOGY SYSTEMS, INC.
