ORDER PERMITTING CONTINUED
PROBATIONARY REGISTRATION

THIS MATTER came on regularly for hearing before the State Gaming Control Board at Carson City on June 17, 1976, and before the Nevada Gaming Commission at Carson City on June 24, 1976; and

THE APPLICANT having presented evidence and made arguments; and

THE STATE GAMING CONTROL BOARD having reviewed the Applicant's operations of the preceding year for compliance with this Commission's Order of Registration of March 20, 1975, as amended; and

On the basis of the evidence submitted by the State Gaming Control Board and by the Applicant;

IT IS THE FINDINGS OF THE COMMISSION:

1. THAT Bally Manufacturing Corporation has alleviated the need for the terms and conditions imposed upon its registration by paragraph 7A of the Order of Registration, and the terms and conditions of said paragraph are deemed to be satisfied by the Applicant.

2. THAT Bally Manufacturing Corporation has substantially complied with the terms and conditions imposed by paragraphs 6 and 7 of the Order of Registration during its first probationary year of registration as a publicly traded company.

1 3. THAT Bally Manufacturing Corporation should be per-
2 mitted to remain registered as a publicly traded corporation
3 according to the provisions of the Order of Registration of
4 March 20, 1975, and subsequent amendments thereto conditioned,
5 however, upon the following additional requirements:

6 a) that as a condition of continued probation Bally
7 Manufacturing Corporation will use its best efforts to dispose of
8 its capital stock in Riksförbundsbingos, on or before October 1,
9 1976, or as soon thereafter as possible; and

10 b) that as a further condition of continued probation
11 Bally Manufacturing Corporation will use its best efforts to
12 enforce the obligations evidenced by the guarantee of Alex Wilms
13 and enforce collections thereof on or before the expiration of
14 the second probationary period.

15 UPON THE FOREGOING AND UPON THE RECOMMENDATION
16 OF THE STATE GAMING CONTROL BOARD, IT IS
17 HEREBY ORDERED BY THE NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION:

18 1. THAT the application of Bally Manufacturing Corpora-
19 tion for Review of the Order of Registration as a publicly
20 traded company be, and the same hereby is, accepted as filed.

21 2. THAT Bally Manufacturing Corporation shall be, and
22 it hereby is, continued to be registered as a publicly traded
23 corporation pursuant to paragraph 2 of the Order of Registration
24 of March 20, 1975, and subsequent amendments thereto.

25 3. THAT the registration of Bally Manufacturing Corpora-
26 tion as a publicly traded corporation be, and hereby is,
27 declared to be probationary for the next two (2) consecutive
28 one year periods, in compliance with paragraph 4 of the Order of
29 Registration of March 20, 1975 and as further conditioned by
30 paragraphs 3(a) and 3(b) of the Findings contained within this
31 Order.

32 4. THAT except as otherwise modified by the terms of this

1 ORDER PERMITTING CONTINUED REGISTRATION, the terms and conditions
2 of the Order of Registration heretofore issued to Bally Manu-
3 facturing Corporation on March 20, 1975, and as subsequently
4 amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
