O R D E R

This matter came before the Nevada State Gaming Control Board at its meeting in Carson City, Nevada, on December 11, 1986, upon the application of BALLY MANUFACTURING CORPORATION for a determination as to whether the Nevada Foreign Gaming Act, NRS 463.680-.720, applies to BALLY MANUFACTURING CORPORATION and its subsidiary, Scientific Games, Inc., in connection with the involvement of Scientific Games, Inc., in governmentally-operated lotteries in other jurisdictions. The Board reviewed all appropriate documents and briefs

1 submitted for its consideration in connection with this matter,
2 and also heard representations of counsel and testimony of
3 witnesses at its aforesaid hearing. Now, being fully advised
4 in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

5 The current activities of Scientific Games, Inc., a
6 subsidiary of BALLY MANUFACTURING CORPORATION, both in
7 connection with sales activities and services provided to
8 governmentally-operated lotteries in other jurisdictions do not
9 constitute "involvement in foreign gaming" as contemplated by
10 the Nevada Foreign Gaming Act, NRS 463.680-.720.

11 Based upon the foregoing findings, the State Gaming
12 Control Board HEREBY ORDERS that a recommendation be filed with
13 the Nevada Gaming Commission that the aforesaid activities of
14 Scientific Games, Inc., do not constitute involvement in
15 foreign gaming and, therefore, that BALLY MANUFACTURING
16 CORPORATION shall not be required to obtain the prior approval
17 of the Commission in order to allow its aforesaid subsidiary,
