AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO ORDER OF REGISTRATION

THIS MATTER came on regularly for hearing before the State Gaming Control Board on December 10, 1980, and before the Nevada Gaming Commission on December 18, 1980, at Carson City, Nevada; and

THE APPLICANT having presented evidence in support of its application; and

THE BOARD AND COMMISSION having considered the report of the Investigations Division and the evidence presented by the applicant;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION UPON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE STATE GAMING CONTROL BOARD:

1. THAT the application of Power Amusement Co., Inc., as amended and supplemented, to acquire a 10% interest of the profits in APT Coin Machine, Inc., a wholly owned subsidiary of Advanced Patent Technology, Inc., through the intermediary holding company, APT Games, Inc., is accepted as filed.

2. THAT paragraph 7 of Amendment No. 1 to Order of Registration of Advanced Patent Technology, Inc, dated October 30, 1980, is hereby rescinded and the following substituted therefor:

"7. THAT APT Coin Machines, Inc., a wholly owned subsidiary of APT Games, Inc., is hereby licensed as a non-restricted slot machine route operator, and the following are licensed in the capacities indicated:

W. Donald Hamilton President, Secretary,
 Treasurer and Director


Power Amusement Co., Inc. 10% of profits

That William C. Power is licensed as President, Secretary, Treasurer, Director and 100% owner of Power Amusement Co., Inc."


3. THAT except as otherwise expressly modified by this Amendment to Order of Registration, all other terms and conditions of Amendment No. 1 to Order of Registration, dated October 30, 1980 and subsequent amendments or other Orders of this Commission are reaffirmed.


