AMENDMENT NO. 4 TO ORDER OF REGISTRATION

THIS MATTER came on regularly for hearing before the State Gaming Control Board on March 10, 1982, and before the Nevada Gaming Commission on March 18, 1982, at Las Vegas, Nevada, and

THE APPLICANT having presented evidence in support of its application, and

NO PERSON having appeared in opposition to the granting of the application, and

THE BOARD AND COMMISSION having considered the report of the Investigation Division,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION UPON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE STATE GAMING CONTROL BOARD:

1. THAT the application of Elsinore Corporation, as amended and supplemented, for an amendment to its Order of Registration, to become a controlling stockholder of Summit Systems, Inc., is hereby accepted as filed.

2. THAT paragraphs 1, 2, 3, and 4 of Amendment No. 3 to Order of Registration, of Elsinore Corporation, dated

August 20, 1981, are hereby rescinded. In substitution therefore, Elsinore Corporation is registered as a publicly traded corporation and found suitable to be a controlling stockholder of Summit Systems, Inc.

3. THAT any offer for the sale of an equity security, as defined by NRS 463.484, by any affiliated company of Summit Merger Corporation, either by a public offering or a private placement, shall not become effective without the prior approval of the Nevada Gaming Commission.

4. THAT except as otherwise expressly modified by this Amendment to Order of Registration, or other Commission action, all other terms and conditions of Amendment No. 3 to Order of Registration, dated August 20, 1981, are reaffirmed and incorporated by reference herein.




