ORDER OF REGISTRATION

THIS MATTER came on regularly for hearing before the Nevada Gaming Control Board ("Board") on March 2, 2022, and before the Nevada Gaming Commission ("Commission") on May 19, 2022, at Las Vegas, Nevada; and

THE BOARD AND COMMISSION having considered all information pertinent hereto;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION UPON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE NEVADA GAMING CONTROL BOARD:

1. THAT the following applications, as amended and supplemented, have been filed:

a. The applications of IAC/InterActiveCorp for (i) registration as a publicly traded corporation, and (ii) a finding of suitability as a beneficial owner of MGM Resorts International, and

b. The applications of Barry Charles Diller for a finding of suitability as a beneficial owner and controlling beneficial owner of IAC/InterActiveCorp.

2. THAT IAC/InterActiveCorp is registered as a publicly traded corporation, and is found suitable as a beneficial shareholder of MGM Resorts International.

3. THAT Barry Charles Diller is found suitable as a beneficial owner and controlling beneficial owner of IAC/InterActiveCorp.

4. THAT IAC/InterActiveCorp shall fund and maintain with the Board a revolving fund in the amount of \$25,000 for the purpose of funding investigative reviews by the Board for compliance with the terms of this Order of Registration. Without limiting the foregoing, the Board shall have the right, without notice, to draw upon the funds of said account for the payment of costs and expenses incurred by the Board and its staff in the surveillance, monitoring and investigative review of all activities of IAC/InterActiveCorp, its direct or indirect subsidiaries, and their affiliated entities.

5. THAT pursuant to NRS 463.625, IAC/InterActiveCorp, is exempted from compliance with NRS 463.585 through NRS 463.615, inclusive, and shall instead comply with NRS 463.635 through NRS 463.645, inclusive.

6. THAT IAC/InterActiveCorp, is exempted from NGC Regulation 15 and shall instead comply with the provisions of NGC Regulation 16.

7. THAT the Commission hereby expressly finds that the exemptions hereinabove granted are consistent with the State Policy set forth in NRS 463.0129 and NRS 463.489.
