<u>ORDER</u>

THIS MATTER came on regularly for hearing before the State Gaming Control Board ("Board") on July 2, 1997, and before the Nevada Gaming Commission ("Commission") on July 24, 1997, at Las Vegas, Nevada; and

THE BOARD AND COMMISSION having considered all information pertinent hereto;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION UPON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE STATE GAMING CONTROL BOARD:

1. THAT IGT has filed an application, pursuant to NGC Regulation 5.115(5)(c), for approval to make periodic payments from the Nevada Super Megabucks System over thirty (30) years for winnings equal to or in excess of \$10,000,000.00.

2. THAT, pursuant to NGC Regulation 5.115(5)(11), the provisions of NGC Regulation 5.115(5)(b) are waived, provided, that for the periodic payment of winnings from the Nevada Super Megabucks System for amounts won equal to or in excess of \$10,000,000.00; after the initial payment of \$1 million, IGT shall make equal annual payments of such winnings in an amount not less than 1/30th of the remaining balance for a period of thirty (30) years.

3. THAT the Commission hereby expressly finds that the waiver granted herein is consistent with the public policy set forth in NRS 463.0129.
