AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO SECOND REVISED ORDER OF REGISTRATION

THIS MATTER came on regularly for hearing before the State Gaming Control Board on February 7, 1990, and before the Nevada Gaming Commission on February 22, 1990, at Las Vegas, Nevada; and

THE BOARD AND COMMISSION having considered all information pertinent hereto;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION UPON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE STATE GAMING CONTROL BOARD:

1. THAT the application, as amended and supplemented, of International Game Technology for an amendment to its Second Revised Order of Registration, is hereby accepted as filed.

2. THAT paragraph 4 of the Second Revised Order of Registration of International Game Technology entered on December 21, 1989, is hereby rescinded and superseded in its entirety, and the following language is hereby substituted in lieu thereof:

"4. THAT IGT is licensed as a manufacturer and distributor, as an operator of a slot machine route, and as the sole shareholder of International Acceptance Corporation."

3. THAT except as expressly modified by this Amendment No. 1 to Second Revised Order of Registration, or other Commission action, all other terms and conditions of the Second Revised Order of Registration of International Game Technology entered on December 21, 1989, are hereby reaffirmed and incorporated by reference herein.


