REVISED ORDER OF REGISTRATION

THIS MATTER came on regularly for hearing before the Nevada Gaming Control Board (“Board”) on September 2, 2015, and before the Nevada Gaming Commission (“Commission”) on September 17, 2015 at Las Vegas, Nevada; and

THE BOARD AND COMMISSION having considered all information pertinent hereto;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION UPON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE NEVADA GAMING CONTROL BOARD:

1. THAT the following application, as amended and supplemented, has been filed:
 - a. The application of Isle of Capri Casinos, Inc., for an amendment to its Order of Registration.
2. THAT the Order of Registration of Isle of Capri Casinos, Inc. dated September 16, 2010, is hereby amended and restated, in its entirety, by this Revised Order of Registration.
3. THAT Isle of Capri Casinos, Inc., is registered as a publicly traded corporation.

4. THAT Robert Scott Goldstein, Richard Alter Goldstein and Jeffrey David Goldstein are each found suitable as a beneficial owner and controlling beneficial owner of Isle of Capri Casinos, Inc.

5. THAT Isle of Capri Casinos, Inc. shall maintain a gaming compliance program for the purpose of, at a minimum, performing due diligence, determining the suitability of relationships with other entities and individuals, and to review and ensure compliance by Isle of Capri Casinos, Inc., and its subsidiaries and any affiliated entities, with the Nevada Gaming Control Act (the "Act"), as amended, the Commission's Regulations (the "Regulations"), as amended, and the laws and regulations of any other jurisdictions in which Isle of Capri Casinos, Inc., and its subsidiaries and any affiliated entities, may conduct gaming operations. The gaming compliance program, and amendments thereto, and the members of the gaming compliance committee, one such member who shall be independent and knowledgeable of the Act and Regulations, shall be administratively reviewed and approved by the Chairman of the Board or his designee. Isle of Capri Casinos, Inc., shall amend the gaming compliance program, or any element thereof, and perform such duties as may be requested or assigned by Chairman of the Board or his designee, relating to a review of activities relevant to the continuing qualifications of Isle of Capri Casinos, Inc., under the provisions of the Act and Regulations.

6. THAT Isle of Capri Casinos, Inc., shall fund and maintain with the Board a revolving fund in the amount of \$25,000 for the purpose of funding investigative reviews by the Board for compliance with the terms of this Order of Registration and any amendments thereto. Without limiting the foregoing, the Board shall have the right, without notice, to draw upon the funds of said account for the payment of costs and expenses incurred by the Board and its staff in the surveillance, monitoring, and investigative review of all activities of Isle of Capri Casinos, Inc. its affiliated companies.

7. THAT Robert Scott Goldstein, Richard Alter Goldstein and Jeffrey David Goldstein shall not, without the prior approval of the Commission, engage in any transaction that would result in a change of control of B.I.J.R.R. Isle, Inc, B.I. Isle Partnership, L.P., IG Isle Partnership, L.P., Goldstein Group, Inc., Jeff Isle Partnership, L.P., Rich Isle Partnership, L.P., Rob Isle Partnership, L.P. or GFIL Holdings, LLC.

8. THAT pursuant to NRS 463.625, Isle of Capri Casinos, Inc., is exempted from compliance with NRS 463.585 through NRS 463.615, inclusive, and shall instead comply with NRS 463.635 through NRS 463.645, inclusive.

9. THAT Isle of Capri Casinos, Inc., is exempted from NGC Regulation 15 and shall instead comply with NGC Regulation 16.

10. THAT the Commission hereby expressly finds that the exemptions and conditions herein are consistent with the State policy set forth in NRS 463.0129 and 463.489.
