THE NEVADA GAMING CONTROL BOARD (NGCB) RELEASED FIGURES TODAY SHOWING THAT \$151.6 MILLION WAS WAGERED IN NEVADA'S 186 SPORTS BOOKS ON THIS YEAR'S SUPER BOWL.

NGCB CHAIRMAN KIRK HENDRICK SAID, "UNAUDITED FIGURES SHOW A NEW ALL-TIME RECORD FOR SPORTS BOOK WIN FROM THE SUPER BOWL OF \$22,134,104 WAS RECORDED ON WAGERS TOTALING \$151,618,159. THIS RESULTED IN A HOLD PERCENTAGE OF 14.6%."
