12	near the games or machines to which the payoff schedule applies. Each licensee shall record
13	the following information in a progressive log:
14	(a) [t] The base amount of each progressive payoff schedule when first exposed for play
15	[and subsequent to each payoff.];
16	(b) Except as otherwise specified in this section, [A]at least once a day, [each licensee
17	shall log] the amount of each progressive payoff schedule at the licensee's establishment
18	[except for those that can be paid directly from a slot machine's hopper or those offered in
19	conjunction with an inter-casino linked system].
20	(c) Progressive payoff schedules which are less than \$1,200 and offered in conjunction
21	with a slot machine are not required to be recorded in a progressive log on a recurring basis.
22	(d) For progressive payoff schedules of \$1,200 or more that are offered in conjunction with
23	a slot machine, nonrestricted licensees shall log the amount of each progressive payoff
24	schedule not less often than once every 7 days if the progressive payoff schedule is linked to
25	a slot machine or slot machines that are connected to a Board approved on-line slot metering
26	system and the metering system records information that can be used to reasonably calculate
27	the progressive payoff; and
28	(e) For progressive payoff schedules required to be logged by this section, [E]explanations

1	for reading decreases [shall be maintained with the progressive logs. When the reduction is]
2	attributable to a payoff, [the licensee shall record] the date of payoff, the payoff amount, and
3	the payoff form number [on the log or have the number reasonably available].
4	→For progressives offered in conjunction with an inter-casino linked system, licensees
5	shall follow the requirements set forth in section 5.112.
