

## Bonus Spin Xtreme (BSX) for Pai Gow Poker Version 2

**Rules of Play** 

Bonus Spin Xtreme for Pai Gow Poker Version 2 is a fixed-amount progressive wager that can be configured on Pai Gow Poker tables. The Bonus Spin Xtreme for Pai Gow Poker Version 2 features an electronic virtual wheel which is spun when a qualifying trigger event occurs. The amount of the side wager may be configured as either \$1, \$2, or \$5. The wager may be optional or mandatory at the discretion of the operator. Bonus Spin Xtreme for Pai Gow Poker Version 2 uses 2 wheels:

- The Inner Prize Wheel (Base Prize Wheel) is for all participating Bonus Spin Xtreme players to win if a trigger event occurs.
- The Outer Prize Wheel (Power Up) is Awarded if the player's outer spin results in the Power Up Award.

If configured as optional the Player may place the Bonus Spin Xtreme for Pai Gow Poker Version 2 wager at the beginning of the game, at the same time as their main wager. If configured as mandatory the player must place the wager at the beginning of the game. The game is played using a 53-card deck with the 52 standard cards and 1 Joker. The Pai Gow Poker main game is then played as normal. The wager is resolved when a qualifying trigger event occurs.

The qualifying trigger event is met if a player is dealt a Flush consisting of 5 or more cards when the Bonus Spin Xtreme Power Up wager is placed, then they will be awarded a spin of the base prize wheel. Otherwise, the wager loses.

After all wagers have been placed, the dealer will press "Start Round" and lock up all of the side wagers. Pai Gow Poker is then played per underlying procedures and house rules. All the Pai Gow Poker wagers will then be settled.

**Note:** Each Player that made the Bonus Spin Xtreme – Power Up wager and met the triggering event will spin the Inner prize wheel in the order of their seats.

**Note:** Depending on the system settings or sensor malfunction, the dealer may initiate the spin on behalf of the player by pressing the highlighted player position on the dealer terminal.

The dealer completes all players winning payouts for the table.

## Options:

Casino operators can choose from the following:

- The amount of the side wager may be configured as either \$1, \$2, or \$5.
- The wager may be configured as optional or mandatory.
- The progressives are designed to be linkable across other games using Bonus Spin Xtreme (locally only) if the operator chooses.
