



EZ Baccarat Progressive

RULES OF PLAY:

- 1) EZ Baccarat offers two optional progressive side wagers.
- 2) The progressive wager payouts are based on the occurrence of a Panda 8 or Dragon 7.

Note: 'Panda 8' means a winning Player 3-Card 8 and 'Dragon 7' means a winning Banker 3-Card 7
- 3) The wager will pay according to the best qualifying event.
- 4) For certain paytables, a Dealer Envy pay is awarded to the dealer for each winning player. A total of 8 suited hand combinations will be printed on the layout (one combination per player position):
 - Player Hand Suited in Clubs & Banker Hand Suited in Diamonds
 - Player Hand Suited in Clubs & Banker Hand Suited in Hearts
 - Player Hand Suited in Diamonds & Banker Hand Suited in Clubs
 - Player Hand Suited in Diamonds & Banker Hand Suited in Spades
 - Player Hand Suited in Hearts & Banker Hand Suited in Clubs
 - Player Hand Suited in Hearts & Banker Hand Suited in Spades
 - Player Hand Suited in Spades & Banker Hand Suited in Diamonds
 - Player Hand Suited in Spades & Banker Hand Suited in Hearts

Note: If the game is configured with less than 8 positions, the operator can select which of the above listed combinations will not be printed on the layout.

5) If the Panda 8 or Dragon 7 outcome matches one of the above-listed suited combinations, the wagering player sitting at the matching seat position will win 100% of the progressive. If there is not a wagering player at the winning seat position, the 100% award is not won.

6) Regardless of whether the 100% award is won or not, all other wagering players will win the Panda 8 or Dragon 7 (Each Hand Suited) award. Likewise, if both the Player and Banker hands are each suited, but not one of the suited combinations listed above, then all wagering players win the Panda 8 or Dragon 7 (Each Hand Suited) award.

7) The Sample Dragon 7 payable is listed below.

8) The Sample Panda 8 payable is listed below.

9) To begin each round, players make their standard Baccarat wager(s). They may also make the Dragon 7, Panda 8, and progressive wagers. Players must place the progressive wagers on the sensor(s) in front of their betting position. The sensor will spin indicating a chip is placed.

10) Once all players place their bets, the dealer will press "START GAME" on the DealerPad. The sensors will then light up, indicating a progressive wager. The dealer will then remove all progressive bets from the table.

11) The dealer then follows house procedures for dealing Baccarat.

12) The dealer reconciles the standard baccarat wagers, any bonus wagers and progressive wagers at the same time. Follow the procedure in the next section for reconciling percentage pays from the progressive meter.

- It is left to the operator's discretion as to whether or not the player may make the Dragon 7, Panda 8, and/or the progressive wagers without playing the base game of baccarat.

13) Progressive winners:

- a) The percentage pays are paid from the progressive jackpot shown on the progressive meter. Fixed hands are paid from the tray.
- b) The percentage prize pay amount shown on the meter is awarded to the player seated at the winning seat position.
- e) When a player has a progressive winner, the dealer, using the DealerPad, will press the appropriate hand button that corresponds to the player with the winning progressive hand.
- f) The dealer shall then contact a supervisor.
- g) Once the casino verifies the progressive win, the supervisor will press the confirm button. House procedures are then followed for paying the prize.
- h) Once the dealer has reconciled all action, they press "END GAME." This resets the system to begin the next hand.
