

Free Bet Blackjack with Push 22 Progressive Rules of Play

Free Bet Blackjack:

Free Bet Blackjack is a variation of blackjack played using six or eight decks of 52 standard playing cards. The game offers the player “free” double-downs and “free” splits under certain conditions. In return, the dealer pushes instead of busts on a dealer total of 22. The player still wins when he has a blackjack and the dealer has a total of 22.

Free Bet Blackjack also offers a progressive bonus wager that can be either optional or mandatory to play.

The game begins with the player making a Free Bet Blackjack bet. The player is dealt two cards face up. The dealer is dealt one card face up and one card face down.

- * The dealer hits soft 17.
- * All doubling and splitting allowed – up to four split hands.
- * Aces may be re-split, receiving one additional card.
- * The player may double on any number of cards (including after splitting).
- * Player Blackjacks are paid 3 to 2.
- * “Free Bet” option – If the player has a hard 9, 10, or 11, with any number of cards, or has been dealt a pair (excluding fours or ten-valued cards), then the dealer will place a “Free Bet” chip to represent the additional wager that the player would normally have to place in order to double or split.
- * The player can refuse the “Free Bet” option if he does not want to split or double. If the player wishes to double any other total, whether “hard” or “soft”, or split fours or ten-valued cards, he may do so, but will follow the regular procedure by placing an additional wager.
- * The “Free Bet” procedure can be used for re-splitting and also doubling after splitting.
- * When the “Free Bet” option is used with splitting, the player’s original wager moves to the first split hand and the “free bet” is the wager for the second split hand.
- * A dealer total of 22 will push all remaining hands except a player blackjack which will still get paid.

Push 22 Progressive:

- * Push 22 Progressive is an optional or mandatory \$1 side bet.
- * The bet wins if the dealer busts with exactly twenty-two (22) points.
- * Only six (6) and eight (8) deck games are considered.
- * The player will win 100% of the progressive if the dealer busts with exactly twenty-two (22) points and their cards are 4, 5, 6, and 7 of a specified suit.
- * The player will win 10% of the progressive if the dealer busts with exactly twenty-two (22) points and their cards are 4, 5, 6, and 7 and not all the same suit.
- * The odds of the dealer busting with exactly twenty-two (22) points and their cards are all the same suit is 50 for 1, 40 for 1, 30 for 1 per selected payable.
- * The odds of the dealer busting with exactly twenty-two (22) points and their cards are all the same color is 15 for 1, 10 for 1 per selected payable.
- * The odds of the dealer busting with exactly twenty-two (22) points is 5 for 1.
- * The seed amount for the progressive is \$10,000.
- * Players must make the regular game wager to be eligible to bet on the Push 22 Progressive.
- * Players who made the regular game wager and bet on the Push 22 Progressive will split the progressive if the conditions for the progressive are met.
