Live Roulette Rules of Play

Game Description

Live Roulette is played with a live dealer and physical table-top single zero Roulette wheel, which consists of 37 slots, numbered from 1 to 36, plus a Zero (0), using standard European Roulette rules.

Rules of Play

To begin, players place single or multiple wagers. The dealer then spins the ball in the opposite direction of the spinning wheel. Wagers may be placed until the dealer calls "No more bets." The ball will make a few rotations around the wheel and will land in the numbered pocket of the wheel to determine game outcome. Bets can be placed only during the betting time. If a game round is in progress when player enters the table, he needs to wait for the next one, and then, place his wagers. To place a bet, player chooses a chip and places it on a betting position. Winnings are paid for the winning bets at the end of each game round. There are many ways to place bets in Roulette. Each bet covers a different set of numbers and has a different distribution. The wagers available to players for Live Roulette are listed in Table 1, along with their respective payouts.
