

Game Description

Rising Phoenix is a Baccarat game containing a collection of optional bonus wagers and using 6 or 8 standard, 52-card decks. The game can be offered with standard commission or commission-free. The outcomes of the optional bonus wagers are not dependent on the base game's outcome.

Note that any combination of the available wagers, along with the commission-free mechanism, may be offered:

- On any standard Baccarat game (non-branded).
- In conjunction with any other branded game/wagers (e.g., *Rising Phoenix with Golden Talons Baccarat, etc.*).

Rules of Play

1. To begin each round, players must place a main game wager and may also place any optional bonus and/or progressive wagers.
2. Once all wagers are placed, standard baccarat dealing procedures are followed. All main game wagers are reconciled in the following manner:
 - a. If the PLAYER hand wins,
 - i. The PLAYER wager wins and pays 1 to 1
 - ii. The BANKER and TIE wagers lose
 - b. If the BANKER hand wins,
 - i. The BANKER wager wins and pays 1 to 1
 - ii. The PLAYER and TIE wagers lose
 - iii. **When the operator chooses to offer the game commission-free**, a winning BANKER 3-card 7 hand results in a push on all BANKER wagers.
 - c. If the hands are tied,
 - i. The TIE wager wins and pays 8 to 1
 - ii. The PLAYER and BANKER wagers push
3. All optional wagers are reconciled based on their evaluation criteria.

Optional Bonus Wagers

Operators choose which optional bonus wager(s) they will offer and set all minimum and maximum wagering limits.

Single-Event Bonus Wagers

Players win if the specific outcome is achieved and are paid based on the corresponding payable in Appendix A.

Harmony Progressive

Players win if the PLAYER and BANKER hands tie and are paid based on the specific scenario as listed on the corresponding payable in Appendix B.
