## Approval to Offer Wagers on the DreamHack Masters Las Vegas 2017

On February 10, 2017, the Gaming Control Board granted Regulation 22.120 approval to offer wagers on the DreamHack Masters Las Vegas 2017 eSports competition to be held at the MGM Grand Hotel/Casino on February 15-19, 2017. Approval is granted for all licensed books to post and accept wagers on head to head, single elimination contingencies for all quarterfinal, semifinal and final tournament matchups. Wagering may also encompass the acceptance of futures wagers for the final winner. The DreamHack Masters Las Vegas 2017 approval is subject to the following conditions:

- Licensed books electing to offer these wagers must provide the Enforcement Division with notification of terms via email at ops@gcb.nv.gov.
- Acceptance of wagers for this eSports competition must cease five minutes prior to the start of each scheduled event.
- The official source of results shall be http://masters.dreamhack.com/vegas/.
- All audit procedures detailed in Industry Letter 2011-48 must be adhered to.
- The setting of odds is at the discretion of the book; rules governing this wager shall be available to the public.
- Deviations from, or additions to the contingencies listed above, will require a separate application and approval.
