## INTRODUCTION

**Baccarat Progressive** is a Baccarat Progressive game played with six (6) or eight (8) standard 52-card decks.

## RULES OF PLAY

## **Dealing Procedures**

- 1. To begin each round, players must place a Baccarat Progressive wager to qualify for the progressive jackpot. The casino operator has sole discretion in determining whether players may place optional bonus wagers without participating in the base game of Baccarat. Once all bets are placed, the dealer will press "START GAME" on the keypad. The sensors will illuminate, confirming that progressive wagers are locked in. The dealer will then remove all progressive bets from the table.
  - A) Only one person at each betting spot is able to place the Baccarat Progressive wager.
- 2. The dealer then follows house procedures for dealing baccarat.
- 3. The dealer reconciles the standard wager, side bets, and progressive wagers at the same time.
- 4. At the end of each hand the dealer will swipe "END GAME" and the players are able to place all of their bets for the next betting round.

## **Progressive Winners**

- 1. The percentage pays are paid from the progressive jackpot shown on the progressive meter. The top award, or meter payout, is a community jackpot that is divided equally among all players participating in the progressive wager.
- 2. Other hands are paid from the tray; they do not come off the meter.
- 3. When a player has a progressive winner, the dealer will select the player spot corresponding to the player with the winning progressive hand. The dealer will then press the appropriate hand button on the display (If the hand button is pressed by accident, pressing it again will turn it off).
- 4. The dealer will then press the "Hit Jackpot" button.
- 5. The dealer shall then contact a supervisor.
- 6. Once the casino verifies the progressive win, the supervisor will press the "Pay Jackpot" button. To complete the action, a Supervisor or Executive card(depending on jackpot level) swipe is required. This records the win onto the GM Atlas computer and adjusts the meter appropriately for the prize won. House procedures are then followed for paying the prize. (Reviewing the monitor connected to GM Atlas will show the prize amount to be paid, and a win page may be printed, which can be used to help record the payout for accounting.)

- 7. Once the Supervisor or Executive card (depending on jackpot level) is swiped the prize is logged into GM Atlas Web UI. If the progressive pay needs to be backed out at this point, the award will need to be manually backed out using the GM Atlas manual adjustment feature.
- 8. Once the dealer has reconciled all action, they slide "END GAME." This resets the system to begin the next hand.
- 9. All winning progressive hands that are paid out of the rack are paid the full amount to each player who participated in the progressive wager. When the Progressive Jackpot is won (Banker 3 Card 7 Player 0 Suited or Player 3 Card 8vs Banker 3-card 7 Suited) all participating players will split the Jackpot evenly.
