20 WHEREAS, the Nevada Gaming Control Board (the "Board") filed the above-captioned
21 matter on October 14, 2019;

22 WHEREAS, counsel for Respondent Stephen A. Wynn ("Mr. Wynn") agreed to accept
23 service of the Complaint, and actually accepted service on October 25, 2019;

24 WHEREAS, Mr. Wynn's counsel advised the Board's counsel of their intent to seek
25 dismissal of the Complaint based on a lack of subject matter jurisdiction; and

26 WHEREAS, the parties' respective counsel agree it will promote economy and efficiency
27 to address the jurisdictional question before proceeding to a substantive hearing in this matter, and
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1 that such economy and efficiency can best be achieved through an agreed-upon briefing schedule
2 and proposed hearing date as set forth below.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by and between the parties, through
4 their respective counsel of record as follows:

5 1. Mr. Wynn will file his forthcoming Motion to Dismiss on or before November 14,
6 2019. Mr. Wynn shall serve Board counsel electronically by November 14, and shall file a hard
7 copy with the Nevada Gaming Commission (the "Commission") no later than November 15, 2019;
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9 2. The Board shall file its Response to the Motion to Dismiss on or before November
10 27, 2019. The Board shall serve Mr. Wynn's counsel electronically and file with Commission by
11 12:00 p.m. noon on November 27;

12 3. Mr. Wynn shall file his Reply on or before December 9, 2019. Mr. Wynn shall serve
13 Board counsel electronically by December 9, and shall file a hard copy with the Commission no
14 later than December 10, 2019;


15 4. Subject to the Commission's discretion, the parties propose that a hearing be held

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1 his Answer shall be due 20 days after the Commission's written decision.



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
