THIS MATTER came on for hearing before the Nevada Gaming Commission (Commission) on November 15, 2018. The Commission having considered all information relevant thereto finds that there is good cause for appointment of a committee pursuant to Nevada Revised Statute 464.020(5). Therefore, pursuant to the unanimous vote of the Commission;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The following pari-mutuel licensees, who are licensed to engage in off-track pari-mutuel wagering pursuant to Chapter 464 of the Nevada Revised Statutes, are hereby appointed to the Pari-Mutuel Wagering Committee (Committee);

Per NRS 464.020(5)(a):

- 1. Palace Station
- 2. Caesars Palace
- 3. South Point Hotel and Casino
- 4. The Orleans
- 5. Excalibur

Per NRS 464.020(5)(b):

- 1. Brandywine Bookmaking, LLC dba William Hill
- 2. CG Technology, LP dba CG Technology dba The Venetian Casino Resort and The Palazzo Resort
- 3. Aquarius Gaming, LLC dba Aquarius Casino Resort

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1 Per NRS 464.020(5)(c):

- 2 1. Paragon Paradise Tenant, Inc. dba Westgate Las Vegas Resort & Casino
- 3 2. The Mirage Casino-Hotel, LLC dba The Mirage
- 4 3. Wynn Las Vegas, LLC dba Wynn Las Vegas

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6 2. The Committee is granted the exclusive right to negotiate an agreement relating  
7 to off-track pari-mutuel wagering with:


- 8 a. A person who is licensed or otherwise permitted to operate a wagering  
9 pool in another state; and
- 10 b. A person who is licensed pursuant to Chapter 464 of the Nevada Revised  
11 Statutes as an operator of a system.

12 3. Each pari-mutuel book shall have the authority to determine individually whether  
13 to accept the terms of any agreement negotiated by the Committee.

14 4. The appointment of the committee and its authority is for five (5) successive  
15 periods of one (1) year each from the date of the Commission meeting in the month that the  
16 approval was granted and shall renew automatically for each of the five (5) successive periods  
17 unless a member of the Commission requests the matter be placed on the Commission  
18 agenda for formal consideration. Unless terminated earlier, the appointment of the Committee  
19 and its authority shall expire at midnight of the November 2023 Nevada Gaming Commission  
20 meeting on the date the matter is considered.
