**ORDER OF DENIAL**

THIS MATTER having come on for hearing before the NEVADA GAMING CONTROL BOARD ("BOARD") on June 11, 2025, in Las Vegas, Nevada, on the above-captioned application and request, with STEVEN ANDREW CHIMARUSTI ("CHIMARUSTI") having failed to appear at the hearing after having been properly sent notice of the hearing via the United States Postal Service to the last known mailing address on file with the Board and via electronic mail to the previously verified electronic mail address on file with the Board, and the Board having received and reviewed all information relative thereto;

WHEREAS the BOARD having denied the Request to Withdraw Application in accordance with Nevada Gaming Commission ("NGC" or "Commission") Regulation 4.140;

AND WHEREAS the BOARD having determined that CHIMARUSTI failed to satisfy the burden of proving his qualifications to be licensed as a key employee of 7689 TAVERN, LLC (dba The Parlor), pursuant to Nevada Revised Statute ("NRS") 463.5735

1 and NGC Regulation 3.110, as required by NRS 463.170(1) and (2), and NGC Regulation  
2 3.090(1), and having specifically found:

3 1. CHIMARUSTI failed to establish that he is a person of good character,  
4 honesty and integrity as required in NRS 463.170(1)(a) and NGC Regulation 3.090(1)(a);

5 2. CHIMARUSTI failed to demonstrate that he has adequate business  
6 competence and experience for the role and position for which he has applied for licensure  
7 as required in NGC Regulation 3.090(1)(c);

8 3. CHIMARUSTI's prior activities, reputation, and habits pose a threat to the  
9 public interest of this State and to the effective regulation and control of gaming, and create  
10 and enhance the dangers of unsuitable, unfair, or illegal practices, methods or activities in  
11 the conduct of gaming and in the carrying on of the business and financial arrangements  
12 incidental thereto in violation of NRS 463.170(2)(b); and

13 4. CHIMARUSTI failed to appear at the June 11, 2025 hearing on his application  
14 and request, after having been properly noticed thereof, in violation of NGC Regulation  
15 4.120;

16 AND WHEREAS the BOARD makes the findings and conclusions set forth herein  
17 based upon the information and materials provided and obtained during its investigation  
18 of CHIMARUSTI's application;
