**REQUEST TO WITHDRAW

THIS MATTER having come on for hearing before the Nevada Gaming Control Board (BOARD) on July 15, 2020, upon the application of SAMUEL COLT WALKER, LLC, dba RENO FIRESIDE (FIRESIDE), for a Restricted Gaming License, upon the application of SAMUEL COLT WALKER (WALKER) for licensure as sole member and manager, and upon the request to withdraw the applications;

WHEREAS, THE BOARD having denied the request to withdraw the applications in accordance with Nev. Gaming Comm'n. Reg. 4.140;

AND WHEREAS THE BOARD, having received and reviewed all information relative thereto, and SAMUEL COLT WALKER having failed to appear before the BOARD after having notice and opportunity to appear;

AND WHEREAS THE BOARD, having determined that FIRESIDE failed to satisfy the burden of proving its qualifications for a restricted gaming license and SAMUEL COLT WALKER failed to satisfy his burden of proving his qualifications to be licensed as sole

1 member and manager of FIRESIDE as required by NRS 463.170(1) and (2). Specifically,
2 the BOARD having found that SAMUEL COLT WALKER failed to meet the requirements
3 of NRS 463.170(2)(a) and (b) by failing to prove himself to be a person of good character,
4 honesty and integrity, failing to prove that his prior activities, criminal record, reputation,
5 habits and associations do not pose a threat to the public interest of the State of Nevada or
6 to the effective regulation and control of gaming based on the following:

- 7 1. WALKER has an outstanding felony warrant and an outstanding misdemeanor
8 warrant in Eagle County, Colorado;
- 9 2. WALKER was a witness in two FBI murder for hire investigations involving
10 associates of WALKER who sought to convince WALKER to murder two people;
- 11 3. WALKER failed to disclose information to the BOARD and reported inaccurate
12 information in his application to the BOARD;
- 13 4. WALKER provided false information on an employment application and was
14 hired based on false information;
- 15 5. WALKER has a history of portraying himself as a former U.S. Navy Seal
16 although he never was a U.S. Navy Seal;
- 17 6. WALKER failed to disclose prior legal names on an application for a concealed
18 weapons permit; and
- 19 7. WALKER failed to appear before the BOARD to address the issues of concern
20 identified through the BOARD'S investigation.

3 of FIRESIDE'S and SAMUEL COLT WALKER'S applications, be and hereby is issued to
4 the Nevada Gaming Commission pursuant to NRS 463.1405(3) and 463.210(3), said
5 recommendation being based upon NRS 463.0129 and NRS 463.170.


